SUMMARY: House Joint Resolution 982 provides for the confirmation by the General Assembly of the appointment of Robert Schurmeier as Director of the State Bureau of Investigation.

[The PCS makes the bill a joint resolution, makes technical corrections, and changes the term of office from July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2024, to eight years beginning on the date of confirmation.]

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 143B-926 provides that the Director of the State Bureau of Investigation shall be appointed by the Governor for a term of eight years, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly by joint resolution.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Joint Resolution 982 confirms the appointment by the Governor of Robert Schurmeier as the Director of the State Bureau of Investigation for a term beginning on the effective date of the resolution and expiring eight years from that date.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The resolution becomes effective upon ratification.
