SUMMARY: *Senate Bill 185 would clarify credit for time served as recommended by the North Carolina Sentencing and Policy Advisory Commission.*

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 185 would amend G.S. 15-196.1 to clarify that credit for time served does not include any time that a defendant has spent in custody as a result of a pending charge while serving a sentence imposed for another offense.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act becomes effective December 1, 2015.
