SUMMARY: The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for Senate Bill 391 would allow extension of an order issued in a street gang nuisance abatement case after a court hearing.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 14-50.43 authorizes a court to find a street gang a public nuisance and to issue an order enjoining a particular person from engaging in criminal street gang activities and imposing other reasonable requirements to prevent the person or a gang from engaging in future criminal street gang activities. The order is valid for one year unless modified, rescinded, or vacated prior to the expiration of one year.

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for Senate Bill 391 would allow a street gang public nuisance order under G.S. 14-50.43 to be extended beyond one year by the court for good cause.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
