SUMMARY: Sec. 1 of S.L. 2015-263 increases the North Carolina Horse Council assessment from \$2.00 to \$4.00 per ton of commercial horse feed, and provides that the assessment is levied for a period of 10 years, up from 3 years. By statute, the Council must use these funds to promote the interests of the horse industry.

This section became effective September 30, 2015.
