SUMMARY: Sec. 27 of S.L. 2015-263 reduces the penalty for failure to guard a fire by watchman from a Class 3 misdemeanor to an infraction.

This section became effective September 30, 2015.

BILL ANALYSIS: Section 27 of S.L. 2015-263 reduces the penalty for failure to guard a fire by watchman from a Class 3 misdemeanor to an infraction. Article 22 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes contains several similar violations with more severe penalties:

- G.S. 14-136, Setting fire to grass and brushlands and woodlands, punishable as a Class 2 misdemeanor or a Class I felony.
- G.S. 14-137, Willfully or negligently setting fire to woods and fields, punishable as a Class 2 misdemeanor.
- G.S. 14-138.1, Setting fire to grassland, brushland, or woodland, punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective September 30, 2015.
