SUMMARY: The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for Senate Bill 519 would create in statute a legislative policy concerning child custody determinations.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to H764 ("Presumed Shared Parenting"), as introduced by Reps. Horn, Jeter, which is currently in House Judiciary III.]

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for Senate Bill 519 would enact a new G.S. 50-13.01 declaring the legislative policy relating to child custody, and would require the court in a child custody proceeding to consider certain factors and make specific findings of fact relating to those factors.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
