

SENATE BILL 597: Repeal References to ABCs

SUMMARY: S.L. 2015-65 makes conforming changes by repealing statutory references to the ''ABCs'' Program and related performance recognition no longer being used in the State.

This act became effective June 11, 2015.

BACKGROUND: The ABCs of Public Education was an accountability plan developed in the 1990s to improve public schools in North Carolina by focusing on strong Accountability with an emphasis on high educational standards; teaching the Basics; and local Control. The current school performance measures used by the State Board of Education for accountability are no longer based on the ABCs model.
