

SENATE BILL 748: Change Report - Building and Infrastructure Commission.

OVERVIEW: S.L. 2016-24 provides that the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State must submit its final report to the 2017 General Assembly, on or before December 31, 2016.

This act became effective June 22, 2016.

PRIOR LAW: The Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State (Commission) was established by S.L. 2014-42. The Commission is comprised of 20 members and studies matters related to building and infrastructure needs, including new repairs, renovations, expansions, and construction in North Carolina. Under prior law, the Commission was directed to make a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 2016 Regular Session of the 2015 General Assembly.

BILL ANALYSIS: S.L. 2016-24 provides that the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State shall submit its final report to the 2017 General Assembly, on or before December 31, 2016.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective June 22, 2016.
