SUMMARY: Senate Bill 748 would extend the final reporting date of the Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State from the 2016 Short Session of the General Assembly, as recommended by that Commission.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to H951, as introduced by Rep. Arp, which is currently in House Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House.]

CURRENT LAW: The Blue Ribbon Commission to Study the Building and Infrastructure Needs of the State (Commission) was established by S.L. 2014-42. The Commission is comprised of 20 members and studies matters related to building and infrastructure needs, including new repairs, renovations, expansions, and construction in North Carolina. As currently written, the Commission is to make a final report of its findings and recommendations to the 2016 Regular Session of the 2015 General Assembly. The Commission will terminate on December 31, 2016 or upon the filing of its final report whichever occurs first.

BILL ANALYSIS: The bill changes the timeframe for the final report of the Commission to be submitted to the 2017 General Assembly.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act will be effective when it becomes law.
