

SENATE BILL 770: North Carolina Farm Act of 2016, Sec. 11: Establish Voluntary Assessment on Deer Feed

OVERVIEW: Sec. 11 of S.L. 2016-113 creates a voluntary assessment on farmed cervid feed to be administered by the North Carolina Deer and Elk Farmers Association ("Association"), not to exceed four dollars (\$4.00) per ton of farmed cervid feed. The assessment may not be levied for a period longer than ten years. All funds paid into the assessment are refundable upon written request to the Association.

This section became effective July 26, 2016.
