

SENATE RESOLUTION 896: Confirm Ben Shelton/Agriculture Board.

SUMMARY: Senate Resolution 896 provides for the confirmation of the appointment of Ben Shelton to the Board of Agriculture to represent the dairy and cattle interest of the State. His term will expire May 1, 2021.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 106-2 creates the Board of Agriculture consisting of the Commissioner and 11 other members from the State so distributed as to reasonably represent the different sections and agriculture of the State. Members of the Board are appointed by the Governor and with the consent of the Senate for six years.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Resolution 896 confirms the appointment of Ben Shelton to the Board of Agriculture as the dairy and cattle representative for a term expiring on May 1, 2021.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The resolution becomes effective upon ratification.
