OVERVIEW: House Bill 256 would modify the term limit on a member of the Vocational Rehabilitation Council and modify the terms of members of the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art appointed by the General Assembly.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 256 would eliminate the two consecutive term limit for the member of the Vocational Rehabilitation Council representing a parent training and information center.

The bill would also amend membership of the Board of Trustees of the North Carolina Museum of Art by extending the term of General Assembly appointees from two years to four years and by giving them a limit of three consecutive terms instead of two (other appointments are for terms of six years with a limit of two consecutive terms).

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** The act would be effective when it becomes law.
