OVERVIEW: *The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) for House Bill 773 amends the ABC laws governing the sale of alcoholic beverages at sports and entertainment venues.*

BILL ANALYSIS: Section 1 would define "Sports and entertainment venue" as stadiums, ballparks, and other similar facilities with a permanently constructed seating capacity of 3,000 or more which are not located on the campus of a school, college, or university.

Section 2 would add "Sports and entertainment venues" to the places eligible for an on-premises malt beverage permit, an on-premises unfortified wine permit, and a mixed beverage permit.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
