OVERVIEW: *House Bill 989 would amend the Charter of the Town of Madison to allow its Town Manager to reside within a 15 mile radius of the Town limits. The act would become effective when it becomes law.*

CURRENT LAW: Section 5.1 of the Madison Town Charter, S.L. 1973-289, requires the Town Manager to reside within the Town during the Manager's tenure in office.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 989 would amend Section 5.1 of the Madison Town Charter to allow the Town Manager to reside within a 15 mile radius of the Town limits during the manager's tenure in office.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act would become effective when the bill becomes law.
