

SENATE BILL 257: Appropriations Act of 2017, Sec. 17.5: Attorney General's Office Management Flexibility Reduction.

OVERVIEW: Sec. 17.5 of S.L. 2017-57 mandates that in allocating the management flexibility reduction required by S.L. 2017-57 for both fiscal years of the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium, the following requirements must be met:

- All reductions from the Department of Justice must only be from fund codes 1991 [Indirect Reserve], 1100 [General Administration], and 1200 [Legal Services].
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law and during the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium, no reductions or transfers can be taken from fund codes 1400 [State Crime Laboratory] and 1500 [Criminal Justice Training and Standards].

This section became effective July 1, 2017.

BILL ANALYSIS: Sec. 17.5 of S.L. 2017-57 mandates that in allocating the management flexibility reduction required by S.L. 2017-57 for both fiscal years of the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium, all reductions from the Department of Justice must only be from fund codes 1991 [Indirect Reserve], 1100 [General Administration], and 1200 [Legal Services], and that notwithstanding any other provision of law and during the 2017-2019 biennium, no reductions or transfers can be taken from fund codes 1400 [State Crime Laboratory] and 1500 [Criminal Justice Training and Standards].

EFFECTIVE DATE: This section became effective July 1, 2017.
