OVERVIEW: *S.L. 2017-175 explicitly identifies records in the possession of The University of North Carolina or any of its constituent institutions as public records if they are related to membership in or communication with the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), or any other athletic conference or collegiate sports organization. This act became effective October 1, 2017.*

BILL ANALYSIS: S.L. 2017-175 enacts a new section under Chapter 132 – Public Records. Any of the following items in possession of UNC or any of its constituent institutions, related to membership in or communication with the NCAA, the ACC, or any other athletic conference or organization would be a public record:

- Documents, papers, letters, photographs;
- Films, sound recordings, magnetic or other tapes, electronic data-processing records;
- Artifacts or other documentary material.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective October 1, 2017.
