

SENATE BILL 416: Use of Tourism Funds/Watauga County.

OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 416 modifies the Committee Report to the Current Operations and Capital Improvements Appropriations Act of 2016 (2016 Appropriations Act) (S.L. 2016-94) to provide that funds appropriated to provide a grant-in-aid to Watauga County shall be used only for the Guy Ford Road canoe access on the Watauga River.

CURRENT LAW: Item 45 on page J57 of the Committee Report to the 2016 Appropriations Act appropriates \$50,000 as a grant-in-aid to Watauga County for tourism and development of access points on the New River.

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 416 modifies the Committee Report to the 2016 Appropriations Act to provide that the \$50,000 appropriation to Watauga County shall be used only for the Guy Ford Road canoe access on the Watauga River.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Senate Bill 416 is effective when it becomes law.
