



SENATE BILL 462: Change Name of UNC General Administration.

OVERVIEW: *S.L. 2018-12 changes the name of "The University of North Carolina General Administration" to "The University of North Carolina System Office." All statutory and legal authority powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations or other funds of The University of North Carolina General Administration remain those of The University of North Carolina System Office (System Office). The System Office is not required to immediately replace any stationary, other supplies, or any emblems or other symbols used by the System Office as they existed prior to enactment. The System Office must use funds within its budget to replace these items as necessary.*

This act became effective July 1, 2018.

CURRENT LAW: The General Statutes currently refer to the central office of The University North Carolina as "The University of North Carolina General Administration".

BILL ANALYSIS: This act changes the name of "The University of North Carolina General Administration" to "The University of North Carolina System Office." This change is made throughout the General Statutes. The act states that all statutory and legal authority powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations or other funds of The University of North Carolina General Administration remain those of The University of North Carolina System Office.

The act further states that nothing in it requires the immediate replacement of any stationary, other supplies, or any emblems or other symbols used by The University of North Carolina System Office as they existed prior to enactment. The University of North Carolina System Office must use funds within its budget to replace these items as necessary.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The act became effective July 1, 2018.
