

BILL ANALYSIS:

The House PCS for Senate Bill 566 removes the original contents of the bill and replaces it with a provision that:

- Removes certain property from the Town of Wrightsville Beach and annexes that property into the City of Wilmington.
- Removes property from the City of Wilmington and annexes it into the Town of Wrightsville Beach.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act becomes effective June 30, 2017. For taxable years beginning on or after July 1, 2017, the property being deannexed pursuant to this act will be subject to municipal taxes imposed by the municipality into which it is annexed pursuant to this act, and will no longer be subject to municipal taxes imposed by the municipality from which it is deannexed pursuant to this act.
