OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 582 makes technical corrections to the General Statutes and session laws, as recommended by the General Statutes Commission.

[As introduced, this bill was identical to H229, as introduced by Rep. Davis, which is currently in an unknown committee.]

EFFECTIVE DATE: Section 5 of the act is retroactively effective December 1, 2015. Section 32 of the act is retroactively effective August 6, 2014. The remainder of the act is effective when it becomes law.
