

SENATE BILL 99: Appropriations Act of 2018, Sec. 11B.4: Report Date for Match Requirements/Allow Fund-Raising with State Funds

OVERVIEW: Sec. 11B.4 of S.L. 2018-5 amends S.L. 2017-57, Sec. 11B.8 to add new language requiring the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc. to submit a report with information on private cash and in-kind contributions by October 1 of each year to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services.

This section allows the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc. and local partnerships to use up to 1% of State funds for fund-raising activities and provides that this use is not subject to the expenditure restrictions of Sec. 11B.8.(h) of S.L. 2017-57. The North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc. must submit an additional report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services beginning October 1, 2019, containing the amount of funds expended on fundraising, any return on fund-raising investment, and other information deemed relevant.

This section became effective July 1, 2018.
