**OVERVIEW:** House Bill 1159 would increase the size of the Johnston County Airport Authority (JCAA) from five members to seven members by adding two additional members who would be appointed by the Johnston County Board of Commissioners (Board).

**CURRENT LAW:** The JCAA is composed of five members appointed by the Johnston County Board of Commissioners to serve four-year staggered terms.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 1159 would increase the size of the JCAA by adding two additional members who would be appointed by the Johnston County Board of Commissioners. The Board would appoint the two additional members within 90 days of the effective date of this act and the initial terms of the new members would be staggered as follows:

- One new member's initial term would expire April 30, 2022.
- One new member's initial term would expire March 31, 2024.

Thereafter, the members would serve four-year terms.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would be effective when the bill becomes law.
