OVERVIEW: House Bill 123 would raise the vehicle inspection fee for safety inspections from \$12.75 to \$13.75.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 20-183.7 includes the Inspection Fees and Electronic Authorization Fees set in statute as follows:

Type	<u>Inspection</u>	Authorization
Safety Only	\$12.75	\$.85
Emissions and Safety	23.75	6.25.

The Inspection Fee is retained by the inspection station. The Authorization Fee goes to the State pursuant to G.S. 20-183.7(c) as follows:

BILL ANALYSIS: This bill would raise the authorized fee for a safety inspection only, from \$12.75 to \$13.75. The emissions and safety inspections fees would not change. The authorization fees would not change.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would become effective October 1, 2019.
