**OVERVIEW:** *House Joint Resolution 147 provides for the confirmation of the reappointment of Raymond E. Grace to the office of Commissioner of Banks.*

**CURRENT LAW:** G.S. 53C-2-2 directs the Governor to appoint a Commissioner of Banks, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly by joint resolution. The term of office for the Commissioner is four years.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Joint Resolution 147 confirms the Governor's reappointment of Raymond E. Grace as Commissioner of Banks for a term beginning on April 1, 2019, and expiring on March 31, 2023.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** The resolution becomes effective upon ratification.
