OVERVIEW: *House Bill 191 would appropriate \$1,000,000 to the City of Greensboro to manage the repair or demolition of homes damaged by a tornado occurring on April 15, 2018.*

[As introduced, this bill was identical to S110, as introduced by Sens. Robinson, Tillman, which is currently in Senate Appropriations/Base Budget.]

CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 191 would appropriate, from the General Fund, \$1,000,000 to the City of Greensboro for the 2019-2020 fiscal year in nonrecurring funds to aid in managing the repair or demolition of damaged homes caused by a tornado on April 15, 2018.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This bill would become effective July 1, 2019.
