OVERVIEW: *House Bill 30 would adopt ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official frozen treat.

BILL ANALYSIS: This act would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would become effective when it becomes law.
