**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 30 would adopt ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina. The bill would become effective when it becomes law.*

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official frozen treat.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 30 amends Chapter 145 by adding a new section to adopt ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** House Bill 30 would become effective when it becomes law.
