OVERVIEW: House Bill 30 would adopt ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina. The bill would become effective when it becomes law.

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official frozen treat.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 30 amends Chapter 145 by adding a new section to adopt ice cream as the official frozen treat of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: House Bill 30 would become effective when it becomes law.
