

HOUSE BILL 308:

Regulatory Reform Act of 2020, Sec. 9: **Extend Right to Work Authorization for State** and Local Government Retirees During the **COVID-19 Emergency**

OVERVIEW: Section 9 of S.L. 2020-74 extended the expiration date of a temporary provision concerning the retirement system from August 1, 2020 to August 31, 2020.

This section became effective July 1, 2020.

BACKGROUND: Sec. 4.23 of the COVID-19 Recovery Act (S.B. 704/S.L. 2020-3) temporarily changed the six month separation requirement for Teachers' and State Employee's Retirement System (TSERS) retirees to a one-month separation for persons retiring during a certain period who return to work in a position needed due to COVID-19, and made other associated changes. The section included an expiration date of August 1, 2020.
