

HOUSE BILL 308:

Regulatory Reform Act of 2020, Sec. 31: Clarification Regarding Submission of Certain Component Designs or Proposals

OVERVIEW: Section 31 of S.L. 2020-74 requires the design or proposal for a component or element in the construction of buildings be completed under valid seal of an architect or engineer only when required by the North Carolina State Building Code.

This section became effective July 1, 2020.

CURRENT LAW: Pursuant to G.S. 160D-1106, a city must approve, without further responsibility to inspect, a design or proposal for a component or element in the construction of buildings from a licensed architect or engineer provided certain criteria are met, including that the design or proposal is completed under valid seal of the licensed architect or engineer.
