**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 39 would adopt the osprey as the official raptor of the State of North Carolina.*

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official raptor.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** This act would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish the osprey as the official raptor of the State of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective when it becomes law.
