**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 394 would adopt the Moravian cookie as the official cookie and the USS North Carolina as the official ship of the State of North Carolina.*

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official cookie or official ship.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** This act would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding two new sections to establish the Moravian cookie as the official cookie of the State of North Carolina and the USS North Carolina as the official ship of the State of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective when it becomes law.
