OVERVIEW: *The proposed committee substitute for House Bill 394 would adopt the Moravian cookie as the official cookie and the USS North Carolina as the official ship of the State of North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official cookie or official ship.

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding two new sections as follows:

- To establish the Moravian cookie as the official cookie of the State of North Carolina.
- To establish the USS North Carolina (BB-55) as the official ship of the State of North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: Effective when it becomes law.
