**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 394 would adopt the Moravian cookie as the official cookie.*

**CURRENT LAW:** State symbols and other official adoptions of the State are found in Chapter 145 of the General Statutes. Currently, North Carolina does not have an official cookie or official ship.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** The PCS would amend Chapter 145 of the General Statutes by adding a new section to establish the Moravian cookie as the official cookie of the State of North Carolina.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** Effective when it becomes law.
