Analysis of: First Edition

OVERVIEW: *House Bill 426 would add one additional superior court judge to Superior Court District 18B.*

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 7A-41 assigns one superior court judge to Superior Court District 18B, which is part of Guilford County. Guilford County has a total of five superior court judges, one each is Superior Court Districts 18A, 18B, 18C, 18D, and 18E.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 426 would add one additional superior court judge to Superior Court District 18B, which is part of Guilford County, for a total of two superior court judges in Superior Court District 18B, resulting in a total of six superior court judges in Guilford County.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The additional judgeship would become effective January 1, 2021 and elections conducted in 2020 would be conducted to include the judgeships created by this act. The remainder of this act would be effective July 1, 2020.
