OVERVIEW: House Joint Resolution 506 provides for the confirmation of the appointment of Steve Warren as a special superior court judge for a term of five years. His term will expire five years from the date of appointment.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 7A-45.1(a10) authorizes the Governor, when a judgeship becomes vacant, to submit the name of a nominee to the General Assembly for confirmation by ratified joint resolution. Upon confirmation, the Governor shall appoint the confirmed nominee to that judgeship for a full five-year term beginning upon the judge's taking office.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Joint Resolution 506 confirms the Governor's appointment of Steve Warren as a special superior court judge. The appointment is for five years.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The resolution becomes effective upon ratification.
