OVERVIEW: House Bill 664 would establish a postsecondary educational attainment goal for the State.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 664 would establish a postsecondary educational attainment goal for the State in order to ensure that the State remains economically competitive now and into the future. The State is to make significant efforts to increase access to learning so that by 2030, 2,000,000 residents between the ages of 25 and 44 will have completed a high-quality credential or postsecondary degree.

Beginning September 1, 2020, and annually thereafter, the myFutureNC Commission must report to the General Assembly and the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on the progress of the State reaching the postsecondary attainment goal and the activities of the Commission to further the State towards the goal.

EFFECTIVE DATE: The bill would become effective when it becomes law.
