

## **HOUSE BILL 694:** Designate Legacy Airports.

OVERVIEW: S.L. 2020-62 requires the North Carolina Department of Transportation to designate North Carolina airports meeting certain criteria as legacy airports.

This act became effective July 1, 2020.

**CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:** This act requires the Department of Transportation to name as a legacy airport any North Carolina airport that:

- Is owned and operated by a county or airport authority.
- Was established as an airport or military facility before 1945.
- Contains a terminal building or runway that was built before 1945.
- Has an actively used runway that is at least 6,500 feet long.
- Has contributed significantly to the development of aviation in this State.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act became effective July 1, 2020.
