**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 694 would require the North Carolina Department of Transportation to designate airports meeting certain criteria as legacy airports.*

**CURRENT LAW/BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 694 would require the Department of Transportation to name as a legacy airport any North Carolina airport that meets all of the following requirements:

- Is owned and operated by a county.
- Was established as an airport and has been in continuous operation since at least 1944.
- Contains a terminal building that was built and has been in continuous operation since at least 1944.
- Has an actively used runway that is at least 6,500 feet long.
- Has contributed significantly to the development of aviation in this State.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act is effective when it becomes law.
