**OVERVIEW:** *House Bill 72 would state the North Carolina General Assembly supports the Lincoln County Board of Education or charter schools within Lincoln County to minimally extend the school day in order to have multiple shorter recess periods.*

**CURRENT LAW:** Under Chapter 115C, local boards of education are responsible for structuring instructional days. Charter schools are exempt from statutes and rules applicable to local boards of education, but remain responsible for structuring instructional days under Article 14A of Chapter 115C.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 72 would state the North Carolina General Assembly supports the Lincoln County Board of Education or charter schools within Lincoln County to minimally extend the school day in order to have multiple shorter recess periods.

This act would only apply to the Lincoln County Board of Education and charter schools within Lincoln County.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective when it becomes law.
