OVERVIEW: *House Bill 735 would allow the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.*

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 150B-19(4) prohibits an agency from adopting a rule that repeats the contents of a law, a rule, or a federal regulation.

BILL ANALYSIS: House Bill 735 would allow the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act would become effective when it becomes law.
