

## **HOUSE BILL 735: Adopt Rules Incorporating 2017 Food Code.**

OVERVIEW: House Bill 735 would allow the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

**CURRENT LAW:** G.S. 150B-19(4) prohibits an agency from adopting a rule that repeats the contents of a law, a rule, or a federal regulation.

**BILL ANALYSIS:** House Bill 735 would allow the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This act would become effective when it becomes law.
