OVERVIEW: *S.L. 2019-129 allows the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.*

This act became effective July 19, 2019.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 150B-19(4) prohibits an agency from adopting a rule that repeats the contents of a law, a rule, or a federal regulation.

BILL ANALYSIS: This act allows the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective July 19, 2019.
