

HOUSE BILL 735: Adopt Rules Incorporating 2017 Food Code.

OVERVIEW: S.L. 2019-129 allows the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

This act became effective July 19, 2019.

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 150B-19(4) prohibits an agency from adopting a rule that repeats the contents of a law, a rule, or a federal regulation.

BILL ANALYSIS: This act allows the Commission for Public Health to adopt rules to incorporate all or part of the 2017 United States Food and Drug Administration Food Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act became effective July 19, 2019.
