



SENATE BILL 144: Allow In-State Tuition/Athletic Scholarships.

OVERVIEW: *SB 144 would remove the limitation on recognizing certain full athletic scholarship recipients as residents of North Carolina.*

CURRENT LAW: G.S. 116-143.6 authorizes boards of trustees of constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina to elect by resolution to consider undergraduate students as residents of North Carolina for all purposes when the students receive a non-athletic full scholarship from an entity recognized by the constituent institution. There can be no fiscal impact from administration of the provision, and the constituent institution must maintain at least the current number of North Carolina residents admitted to that constituent institution.

BILL ANALYSIS: SB 144 would authorize constituent institutions to also consider undergraduate students as North Carolina residents for all purposes when the student receives an athletic full scholarship from a recognized entity.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
