OVERVIEW OF AMENDMENT: S-232-ARN-5[v.2] rewrites the contents of the bill so that it does the following:

- *Defines a "program" as any State-administered program that is targeted or directed at veterans, service members, or their families and receives any State funding, but is limited to the twelve programs listed in the amendment.*
- *Requires an administrator of a program to determine the number of the number of veterans, service members, and their families served and the services, benefits, and discounts provided to them and to track outcomes according to measures established by the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.*
- *Requires administrators to report the information collected during the previous fiscal year to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs no later than September 1 of each year.*
- *Beginning December 1, 2020, requires the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs to annually report the information it has received to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government.*
- *Provides that the act is effective when it becomes law.*
