North Carolina Farm Act of 2019-20, Sec. 5(c) and 5(d):

Limit Regulation of Catering by Bona Fide Farms

OVERVIEW: Sections 5.(c) and 5.(d) of S.L. 2020-18 prohibit local governments from requiring a business located on a property used for bona fide farm purposes, that provides on- and off-site catering services, to obtain a permit to provide catering services within the local government. These sections do not exempt the business from any health and safety rules adopted by a local health department, the Department of Health and Human Services, or the Commission for Public Health.

These sections became effective June 12, 2020.

BACKGROUND: These sections were amended by Section 21 of S.L. 2020-74 to correct cross references that changed with the enactment of Chapter 160D.
