OVERVIEW: *Senate Bill 458 would designate July 27 of each year as Posttraumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day in North Carolina. This act would be effective when it becomes law.*

BILL ANALYSIS: Senate Bill 458 would enact G.S. 103-15, designating July 27 as Posttraumatic Stress Injury Awareness Day in North Carolina.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This act is effective when it becomes law.
