

OVERVIEW: Senate Bill 474 abolishes obsolete boards and commissions that are no longer functional. The act is effective when it becomes law. <u>The Proposed Committee Substitute (PCS) adds Sections 19.1 through 19.4 and makes technical changes.</u>

BILL ANALYSIS: The PCS for Senate Bill 474 abolishes all of the following and makes conforming changes:

- The Board of Directors of the Certification Entity for the Phase II Settlement Funds.
- The North Carolina Agency for Telecommunications.
- The Charlotte Douglas International Airport Commission.

- The Commission on School Technology.

- The Motor Vehicle Dealers' Advisory Board.

- The State Advisory Council on Employment Security.
