**OVERVIEW:** *S.L. 2019-178 amends the statutes on living probate, application for letters testamentary or letters of administration, choice of law for out of state wills, and transfer of property held in a tenancy by the entirety to a tenancy by the entirety trust. The amendments were referred to the General Statutes Commission by the Estate Planning and Fiduciary Law Section of the North Carolina Bar Association.
